SUPERCROSS COMES TO BMX

"Hi, sports enthusiasts, B. S. Verbose beaming out another erudite edition of BMX Starcase. I'm broadcasting several hundred yards distant of the Long Beach Veteran's Stadium. Its superstructure, looming heavenward, is casting ominous afternoon shadows across the periphery as the day's shimmering heat waves dance and dissolve

about me. Here, beyond the stadium, stands Narler Park, a beacon of hope, an island of sanctified soil resisting urban encroachment, reassuring all spirits that still savor wholesomeness. apple pie, and stomping the comp.

Most definitely. The new, revitalized, vitamin-enriched, elongated, latest version of Scot Breithaupt's Narler Park tickled the thrill meter and plunked the magic

sections. A running time close to a full 60 seconds. There's jumps. There's bumps. There's triple whoops . . . And then you notice the curves, and the curves are windier, and there's long slender sections of legs . . ." 
money main only paid \$1000. However, an equal amount went to the Pro Cruiser class.

According to Breithaupt, "We're


trying to push the Pro Cruiser class by giving equal purses. The open wheel bikes are faster, easier to handle, more dramatic, and more

the NBA Grand Nationals, left the greenback cake bakers huffin' and puffin'. Super long. Wide. More jumps than the Calaveras County Frog Hoppin' Contest. About 17 of 'em, with all kinds of leapability levels.

Commenting further about the track redesign, Breithaupt said, "The neat thing about this version of Narler is that it's basically new. but it brings back something old gnarlocross. The feel of the rowdy tracks of yesteryear. People have been making freeway tracks for several years, but a change is coming. This track will abuse bikes and riders.'

"I think the NBL is making an effort to improve the tracks and get more Supercross type tracks. The promoters are taking rider suggestions and adding jumps. I

think the racers get more excited by qnarly tracks."

"With all the jumps and short sprints in between, you have to keep calculating, and you have to have endurance to finish. It will increase the training of some of these prima donna Pros. They're gonna have to train to make their money."

Long tracks also de-emphasize the luck of the draw and the start. A rider can bog on the gate and still make a race of it.

Additionally, Pro-only sections up spectator appeal and make racing more attractive for TV coverage. Anyway you look at it, gnarlocross has a bunch of pluses going for it.

Numerous Pros raved about the track. However, none were interviewed while grunting down the last straight. Here's a sampling of

COMMENTS:

- 1. This was one of THEE most bonkers tracks in history. BMX racing at its finest. Supercross.
- 2. Sign-ups were efficient, but scheduling was the pits. The first race started something like three hours late.
- 3. The extra-long, extra-gnarly Pro track and hefty purse in the Pro Open Wheel class (24s and cruisers) were in keeping with growing trends. Longer tracks and larger bikes seems to be where Pro BMX is headed.
- 4. Zero parking and spectator fees and \$20 pre-entry fees were pretty acceptable.

Harry Leary took the Pro Trophy while Mike Miranda headed the B Pro dough chasers.

Semi winners Greg Hill and Tommy Brackens were in the Pro Money main along with Stu, Harry, Jeff Ruminer, Eric Rupe, Bob Woods, and Scott Ahart. Greg, who doubled last December at the NBA Grand Nationals, took it wire-to-wire.

The Narler race could certainly accelerate a shift toward supercross or anarlocross or whatever you want to call longer, more demanding and exciting tracks. Like most of the Pros, we can hardly wait.



DOES THE E.T. **REALLY FLY?**


Unless a weird lookin' squig-gely toad has just kissed you full on the lips - vucch - waking you from a super-long enchantment, you probably already know about Elliott and his extra terrestrial buddy. The E.T. movie may do for BMX what Urban Cowboy did for honky-tonkin' and dressin' up down-home like. You better believe we're gonna be seein' a bunch more kids on BMX bikes.

BMXA grabbed the first available Kuwahara E.T. to reach our shores for an exclusive first look.

Here's a quick recap of what went down in coming up with the bikes that went up, up, and away in the movie. In June of 1981 the producers of the movie, Steven Spielberg (who also directed) and Kathy Kennedy had picked a particular bike model to use. They asked for an opinion from the 12 year old nephew of a staff member. He told them they made a lame pick. When they asked him what he would suggest, he said Kuwahara. The producers then polled about twenty kids. Kuwahara won the poll.

Universal Studios decided to track down Kuwahara. They called the factory in Japan. Those guys told 'em to call Everything Bicycles, the American distributor and designer of Kuwahara bikes. The studio requested a special model bike for the movie. Everything Bicycles' Howie Cohen took about three milliseconds to think it over and say yes.

The film company laid a ton of art boards on Howie and said be fruitful and multiply or something like that. Howie scooped up about 100 bare frames and hired a paint shop for a





day. That netted him 25 different variations of the red-and-white scooter the producers were after. The studio said: "Ah, yes, this is exceedingly fine. Let's roll." Then Universal entered into an exclusive licensing agreement with Kuwahara and Everything Bicycles for E.T. model


The E.T. project began with a KZ

production E.T. isn't a red and white KZ. Kuwahara decided to give the bike more mass market appeal - a lower price. They went with less expensive high-tensile steel (which has a higher carbon content than mild steel). Kuwahara also decided on a loop-type rear end on the frame to reduce welding costs. The KZ's



new super-huge quarter-pipe ramp the Trick Team calls "Kong."

race-proven geometry was virtually duplicated. However, the front section was shortened slightly to widen the bike's age-range appeal.

SunTour helped a bunch in getting the bike ready for marketing. Some component changes were made after the film was shot in August and September of 1981. Dia-Compe Tech II levers weren't available then.

The first thing R.L. and Buff did when they climbed on the E.T. was street it. Of course, to them, street means hauling the ramps outside and lettin' loose.

Naturally, with our gang, testing means taking it to the limits. After the fifth jump off the ramp, E.T. was standing for essential trubs. The rear axle bent.

Upon hearing the news, Kuwahara decided to go with heat-treated axles (front and rear) in the production units.


Admittedly, ramp jumping is a pretty harsh test for what is essentially a dirtable street bike. However, all you rad readers out there benefited because Kuwahara responded to our input by going with the heattreated axles and the chrome-moly fork. As a result, we feel safe in saying the Kuwahara E.T. can take tons of punishment — provided everything is bolted together tightly.

Our riding sessions produced comments like:

"Basically, it's a great design."
"It's a neat street bike."

"It's fine for a kid up to about 15. Put a gooseneck with more offset on it and maybe a bentback seat post and it'd be perfect for larger quys."

"I'd change the grips. Everything else is fine."

That all took place within one

two-month span. And the scooter these red-clad rad riders were blazin' on was the limited edition Super Team Scorpion, just out.

The Super Team is the top-of-theline team bike, featuring the triple-lug frame construction instantly associated with Scorpion. The Super Team is fabricated from 4130 chromemoly. All other Scorpion models are made from Mangaloy tubing — Tange's trademark for magnesium molybdenum, a steel alloy known for its excellent strength-to-weight ratio.

Scorpion feels that their triple-lug





the tube ends into the lugs creates double-thickness strength. In addition, Scorpion uses beefy .049 tubing (many race bikes use .035 tubing) which adds weight but sure makes the thing bullet-proof.

The tube junctions are sweat-

brazed rather than heliarc welded. A nickel silver alloy fuses the tubing together. Brazing requires lower temperatures than heliarc welding. This means the chrome-moly is subjected to less heat stress during frame fabrication.

frames comes from past experience with ten-speed race technology, Current Scorpion owner Paul Hinkston became involved with BMX in 1974 with Shimano. In 1978, he moved to Sentinel, a major name in lightweight

Scorpion's interest in lugged

ten-speeds. At this point, Hinkston began researching applications of ten-speed geometry and construction to BMX. Initially, Sentinel built BMX bikes for other brands. In 1979, they began producing their own Scorpion bikes. Then Cal-Facet bought Scorpion from Sentinel. Later, Hinkston acquired ownership.

The Super Team was developed with input from the team riders. The factory wanted a quick handling,

bulletproof bike that could be sold on a limited production basis. In developing the Super Team, they decided to go with a slightly steeper head angle. They also lengthened the frame some. The decision to use .049 tubing fit in with their desire to aim the bike at the age 13 to 17 beefy

The Super Team should retail for about \$390. The number two bike in the line is the Scorpion Team. It sells

for about \$295 to \$325. The SX is an economy race bike. It goes for \$225 to \$250, depending on finish.

Team Scorpion keeps growing. Close, but no Zagars. Pun fun, but lately Richard hasn't just been coming close, he's been getting there. Head of the pack. Big wins like the Knoxville World Cup. He posted eight NBL wins during last May, June, and early July.

Richard was National No. 4 in 15 Expert last year in the NBL War of the Stars. He joined Scorpion in April.

Scorpion's speedster began racing in 1975 at age ten. Some friends took him to the Van Nuys track in the Los Angeles area and he was hooked. He started his crankin' career on a Mongoose.

He rode a Red Line and JMC before picking up his first factory sponsorship - from Jag. Next. a two year factory stay with Schwinn. Then Richard joined Jeff Bottema and Toby Henderson on Team Raleigh. Last year he was shop sponsored by Europa Bikes.

Before getting hooked on BMX, Richard used to play Pop Warner football and Little League baseball. Now all he has time for is bikes.

He's one of the few BMXers who also competes on tenspeeds. Richard rides a Raleigh Professional in local 25 kilometer races. He has hopes of someday taking a shot at Olympic-level competition. Because of those aspirations, he probably won't turn Pro in BMX.

Richard roller-trains like crazy. usually on his ten-speed, for endurance. His sessions run 30 to 60 minutes. He also weight trains on a Universal Gym with the emphasis on endurance. (Leg presses - 50 repetitions with 200 pounds. Bench presses - 20 reps with 150 pounds.) He jogs about five miles every other day.

Amazingly, Richard doesn't practice starts. "I don't have a gate and I get pretty good starts the way I train right now."

Richard is a junior at Burbank High School. He's thinking about college.

If you have trouble pronouncing the name, it's Zay-gars. Just remember it rhymes with one-ofthe-new-stars and you got it.
