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

Do you think BMX will ever be an Olympic event?



CONSISTENCY IS THE NAME OF THE GAME

ping!Ding! Ding! "Ladies and gentlemen, your attention please! I have in my hand the list of BMX ACTION magazine's pre-race predictions for how the top heavy-weight contenders will finish in this, the second round of the ESPN Pro Series. They are as follows:"

- 1. Eddy King
- 2. Brent Patterson
- 3. Scott Clark
- 4. Stu Thomsen
- 5. Brian Patterson
- 6. Greg Grubbs
- 7. Eric Rupe
- 8. Mike Miranda

"The arena for Round 2 of this heavyweight championship contest is the Waterford Oaks BMX Track in Detroit, Michigan. Now let's go to our referee who's with the challengers for the rules briefing."

"Okay guys, this race will be fought under the format established by the ESPN Pro Series promoters. Scoring will be done on a three main system with low total points taking the overall victory. In case of a tie, the rider with the higher finishing position in the last main will be scored higher."

"We want a clean race. No punching during breaks. No elbows or thumbing. No low blows. Now shake hands, go to the gate, and wait for the lights. Good luck to you all."

BACK TO REALITY

Well, that's not exactly how it happened, but you get the idea. We're talkin' heavy combat. As for the predictions, that IS how we picked 'em for the ESPN TV show. You'll see whether our crystal ball was working properly or was on the blink at the end of this story.

So why did we select Eddy for the top spot, you ask? 'Cause he's in top shape, totally jazzed on racing pro and has absolutely blazed in a few very recent nationals. He is ready. Also, he hasn't been showing any signs of suffering from the "pro rookie blues." that dreaded disease

that usually strikes riders when they move up to the heavyweight division.

Speaking of heavyweights, you're probably wondering why Greg Hill didn't make our list for this race. Well. he had gotten married the week before and we figured his psych was blown.

ON TRACK

We nabbed our top pick, Eddy King, to give us the inside scoop for handlin' the tricky parts of the Waterford track. For more secrets, we grabbed our No. 3 choice. Scott Clark.

Scott on gate positions: "I think lane 1, which is on the very inside, is a disadvantage 'cause the straight narrows down and if someone in the middle gets a good start, they can shut you off really easy. On the outside, you get stuck. The middle positions are the best."

The first turn is a banked lefthanded sweeper with a three-foot dropoff right in the middle. Here's Eddy's attack plan: "I square the corner before the drop. That way you have your turn completed before the dropoff and you don't drift to the outside of the next straight."

The next major obstacle that these guys have to face is two three-foot roller jumps spaced pretty far apart. How does Eddy take 'em? "It all depends on how I come out of the first corner. If I can square off, I'll be on the left side of those doubles and speed jump 'em. If I have to go wide, I'll crank as hard as I can and jump

The third turn is another trouble spot. Scott explains: "It's real slippery so I just try to be smooth through there. If you bump tires with someone, it's an instant eat."

The remainder of the track is pretty standard. Just keep on the gas and don't screw up.

GAME PLANS

Tactics for this series all boil down to one word — consistency. But when the dust cleared after the motos and semis at Waterford, only three riders who were in the Miami ESPN mains were making repeat appearances - Stu, Brent Patterson, and another of the pro newlyweds, Eric Rupe. ("Yup, married life is the best!")

Eric was experimenting with his psych to see if being more mellow would help his performance. "I'm trying to relax and not think of this as a big race - just go out there and do my best."

"You can win this race with three third place finishes. That's what I hope will pay off for me. Consistency will win."



He's been both psyched and envious, seeing the recent successes of his former teammate Eddy King, Another reason for his fast ways is that he's riding for his own company. Pete believes that when you win, you sell bikes. When you don't, well ... you go hungry.

Eddy was hangin' tough with a second and a third. He was sittin' in second overall, and said, "You're not gonna find out the winner till after this last main."

Stu and Brent had traded elbows and words in the first two mains and were in fourth and fifth places re-


Eric Rupe was firmly lodged in third place. Harry was havin' probs with bails and was way back in the standings. At any rate, they were all ready for a fight to the finish.


THE MAIN EVENT

"Harry's helped me a lot with training and things I should work on. The biggest thing I've improved on is my first straights. Now I can bear down and hang with those guys when it gets into handlebar bangin' situations."

Well, that basically wraps it up from here, gang, Eddy played the consistency game and won. Come to think of it, he didn't win a race all day long. But that doesn't matter when you have \$2500 in cash plus some beefy contingency checks coming your way.

As for our predictions, our crystal ball has been sent in for a little fine tuning. We nailed Eddy, came close on Stu, and blew the rest. Next time maybe we'll try a Ouija board.

See you at Round Three in St. Louis.

Eric Rupe, with a fourth at Miami and a fourth here at Waterford, found himself suddenly leading the series in overall points. 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They're everything you ever dreamed.

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
